I instantly get a helmet for security and Kyle start to explaining me everything about his job while he was doing it he install a converter to convert solar energy to electricity he also went to the roof to make sure that everything was good because he is the crew lead he needs to make sure that everything is in order.

What I like the most about the job shadow was that Kyle explains me that is not dangerous to work because they are always working with death electricity which means that an accident could happen but not because of the electricity.

I learn that the electricity that the solar panels get are different from the one that its is the house so it has to get converted. There are three primary technologies by which solar energy is commonly harnessed: photovoltaics (PV), which directly convert light to electricity; concentrating solar power (CSP), which uses heat from the sun (thermal energy) to drive utility-scale, electric turbines; and heating and cooling systems, which collect thermal energy to provide hot water and air conditioning.

After my job shadow I am more interested in working in that company because it's very interesting how people make difference. The difference that they work in a good job they make solar energy to get convert to electricity. Also they payment is good in a year you can make about from 60 000 to 12 000 almost the same as an architect.
